Suggested Learning Intentions

Choose those that apply to the activities that are taught:

- Children will become familiar with the Biblical story of the death and resurrection of Jesus.
- Children will know that the death and resurrection of Jesus is celebrated by Christians at Easter.
- Children will understand that Easter is an important celebration for Christians.
- Children will discuss together the emotions shown in the story.
- Children will consider how they might feel in a variety of situations.



Suggested Success Criteria

- I can demonstrate my knowledge and understanding by sharing my thoughts and asking and answering questions.
- I can demonstrate my knowledge and understanding by sequencing pictures from the story.
- I can tell you where the account of the death and resurrection of Jesus is found and when Christians celebrate it.
- I can demonstrate my knowledge and understanding through art, songs, rhymes and imaginative play.
- I can identify and explain the emotions the characters might feel at different points in the story.
- I am able to express how I might feel in different situations.



Key points from the Story

Christians believe

- The biblical account of the death and resurrection is true.
- Jesus died on a cross. (Crucified)
- Jesus came alive again. (Resurrected)
