

## **ASSEMBLY:**

### **Getting along with everyone.**

### **The story of the Good Samaritan.**

**HWB link:** Sometimes our differences lead to dislike. How can we get on with everyone? Even those people we feel different from?

**Key learning:** We're all different from each other, but if we're willing to think we'll also find similarities with each other. Looking at what unites us, rather than allowing our differences to lead to dislike, can help us to have the maturity to figure out how to get along with everybody.

We learn that a Parable is a story with a deeper meaning and explore how to act towards those we disagree with, by looking at the Biblical parable of the Good Samaritan.

**Content:** We play 'Would you rather?' and discuss what similarities and differences we have. We learn the definition of a parable and hear the story of the Good Samaritan. It teaches us that we should look for the best in everyone, even in the people we disagree with.

**Challenge issued:** To think of someone you disagree with and to list 5 things you have in common and go and do something kind for them.
